4. Jamie buys a twirl for 38p and a double decker for 47p and a galaxy for 76p. He has £3.75 left. How much money did he have to begin with?
5. Sam is saving up to buy his mum some chocolates for her birthday. He has £3.45 in his piggy bank, his dad gave him £2.39 and his nan gave him £1.76. The chocolates cost £12.50. How much more does Sam need to save?
6. In May, 754 people visit the swimming pool. In June the number of visitors increases by 343. What was the total people visit in May and June?
